Renovation of the MIS Senior School Library

Over time a need has been felt to utilize the vast space on the first floor – the "Senior School Library" for a variety of things, rather than the unidimensional reading room that it is today. The space is large, underutilized and creates big clusters of sitting spaces, where once students get together, they are able to create a significant amount of mutual disturbance.

The renovation project undertaken by Mother's Blossoms envisages the following:

- Creation of individual and group carrels in the library to promote individual reading habits, without disturbing other students. This is developed using smaller seating modules for 1/2/4 people rather than for 10-16 people as they exist now.
- Creation of a teacher's lounge where they would have ready availability of books to their specific liking, interest, and related to their teaching courses. It would have some comfort seating as well, and teachers could undertake paper checking, informal child counselling etc. A dedicated internet connection for the teachers to research their course is proposed.
- Creation of a Multimedia room, where a simultaneous electronic library can be developed, with CD's, DVD's and a projector and screen. This area would be air conditioned and cordoned off from the rest of the library with aluminium partitions, and will have a provision for darkening the space inside.
- Create Visible Signage to help lead students/teachers to the correct section.
- A Comprehensive layout change including the reception, so that the space utilized per function is more efficient and utilizes the surrounding natural light effectively.

This project has been divided into two phases and will be completed over a period of two years. We will need approximately Rs 2.5 lacs to see this project through.
